## Medikaloka Hermina (HEAL IJ)

**Buy** (Maintained)

### Unpacking The Djarum Group Investment; Keep BUY

- **Stay BUY and IDR1,580 TP, 12% upside.** Medikaloka Hermina has sold treasury shares to Dwimuria Investama Andalan (DIA, affiliated to Djarum Group), which now holds a 3.64% stake in the company as of 25 June. The selling price was IDR1,875/share, representing c.30% premium to the previous day's closing price. Our TP includes a 6% ESG premium.
- **Rationale behind DIA's investment in HEAL.** DIA noted the existing good relationship among HEAL's founders and its commitment on long-term vision as the main considerations to make the deal. Moreover, DIA sees potential from HEAL's Quantum Leap phase 2 initiative. This programme aims to expand the hospital network to 65-70 facilities, with up to 15k beds total by 2030 (vs 51 hospitals with 8,278 beds as of 1Q25).
- **Why is HEAL collaborating with DIA?** HEAL selected DIA as a partner due to the latter's large business group and workforce, which remains as one of Indonesia's largest conglomerates. Additionally, one of HEAL's founders has familiarity with DIA, although there is no affiliation. HEAL also believes that DIA's corporate ecosystem will help accelerate the growth of its non-BPJS (Social Insurance Administration Organisation) segment, aiming to raise non-BPJS patient volume mix to c.40% in the coming years from 20% currently.
- **DIA's commitments.** DIA sees it as a long-term investment with no management involvement (seats on HEAL's board of directors (BOD) or board of commissioners (BOC)) or formal commitment at this stage (ie achieving a certain key performance indicator (KPI) or increasing stake to a certain level). However, DIA is open to support HEAL's development when needed, especially on increasing the number of private patients.
- **Potential synergies.** HEAL is exploring strategic synergies with Djarum Group, including potential Coordination of Benefits (COB) for product development with its insurance arm and DIA's support in upgrading hospitals to cater more premium segments. HEAL also aims to collaborate with Djarum's HR teams on healthcare initiatives, ie Medical Check-Up (MCU) - tapping into the group's large employee base as growth opportunity.
- **How will HEAL utilise the investment from DIA?** HEAL plans to use the funds from the treasury shares divestment to DIA to prepare for the potential implementation of competency-based hospital services, which may require upgrading each hospital's capabilities to meet Madya classification criteria under the anticipated Indonesian Diagnosis Related Groups (IDRG) system by 2026. While the company still waits for further guidance from the Government, its hospitals are currently conducting SWOT analysis to evaluate readiness - including potential sub-specialist needs - and estimate the required capital expenditure. Key risk: Slower increase in revenue intensity.

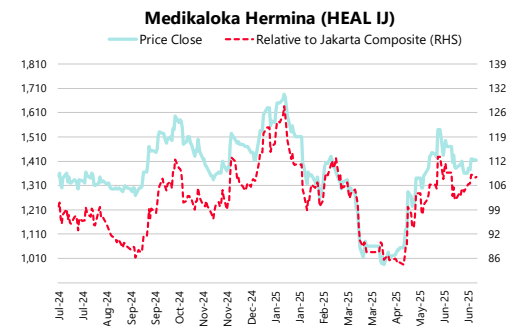

## Latest ESG-Related Developments

Since 2020, HEAL has introduced initiatives to reduce the use of plastic materials. A highlight of such efforts is replacing the use of plastic bags at pharmacies with recyclable paper-based ones. It has also launched awareness campaigns to reduce the consumption of mineral water in plastic cups and bottles, as well as the use of plastic straws in office areas and hospital wards.

Meanwhile, there have been efforts made to manage its energy consumption responsibly, including via the installation of LED lights to replace conventional lamps, maximising natural lighting through glass window installations, efficient use of elevators, room lighting, and air conditioning, especially after office hours and using solar powered lighting at parking areas.

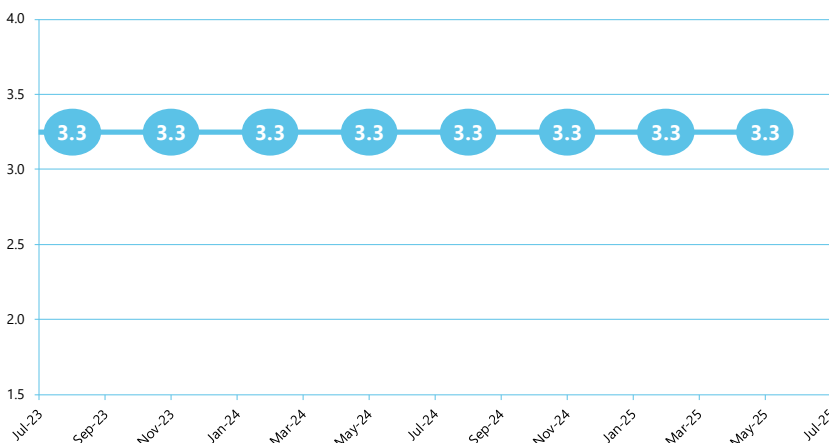

## Supplementary Notes On Shareholder Partnership

**Will there be potential challenges in decision-making process?** Despite the presence of two major Indonesian conglomerates – Astra International (ASII IJ, NEUTRAL, IDR5,200) and Djarum Group – as current investors, HEAL affirms that all shareholders remain fully committed and supportive of the company’s current management’s decisions, which aligns with and drives its long-term growth vision.

**Collaboration with ASII.** HEAL continues to explore potential collaborations with ASII, including initiatives, ie the MCU programme and COB scheme. HEAL is also exploring a collaboration with Halodoc, a telehealth platform backed by ASII. Under this arrangement, ASII employees not covered by insurance that need urgent outpatient care at HEAL can access services through Halodoc, with payments processed via the platform. In addition, Halodoc is involved in the procurement system managed by Media Loka Manajemen (MLM), which enhances HEAL’s pharmaceutical purchasing power and supports efforts to reduce COGS. While any potential increase in ASII’s stake remains at its discretion, the company mentioned that it will continue to monitor opportunities within the healthcare industry. ASII currently holds a 7.23% stake in HEAL.
